

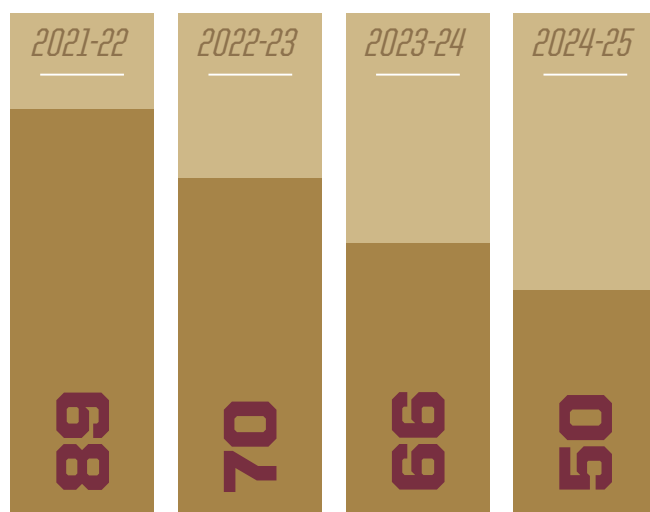
ANNUAL REPORT
